

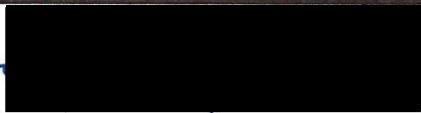

The other parties to a Public Local Inquiry will normally be WSCC, as Order Making Authority, and those opposed to the Order. Each party will be given an opportunity to speak and put their case to the Inspector. It is therefore important that you understand that you may be requested to attend the Public Local Inquiry as applicant and so that your written evidence either in support or against the claimed route can be verbally tested.
