Upgrading the whole of bridleway 2979 to a restricted byway

Adding a restricted byway from point B at the southern termination of bridleway 2979 at a junction with byway 826 to point C at grid reference SU841161

Adding a byway open to all traffic from point C to point D at a junction with a public road at grid reference SU837155


