
adding a restricted byway 30 ft wide from point A at a junction with Thicket Lane on or around grid reference SU926087 to point B at or around grid reference SU924082

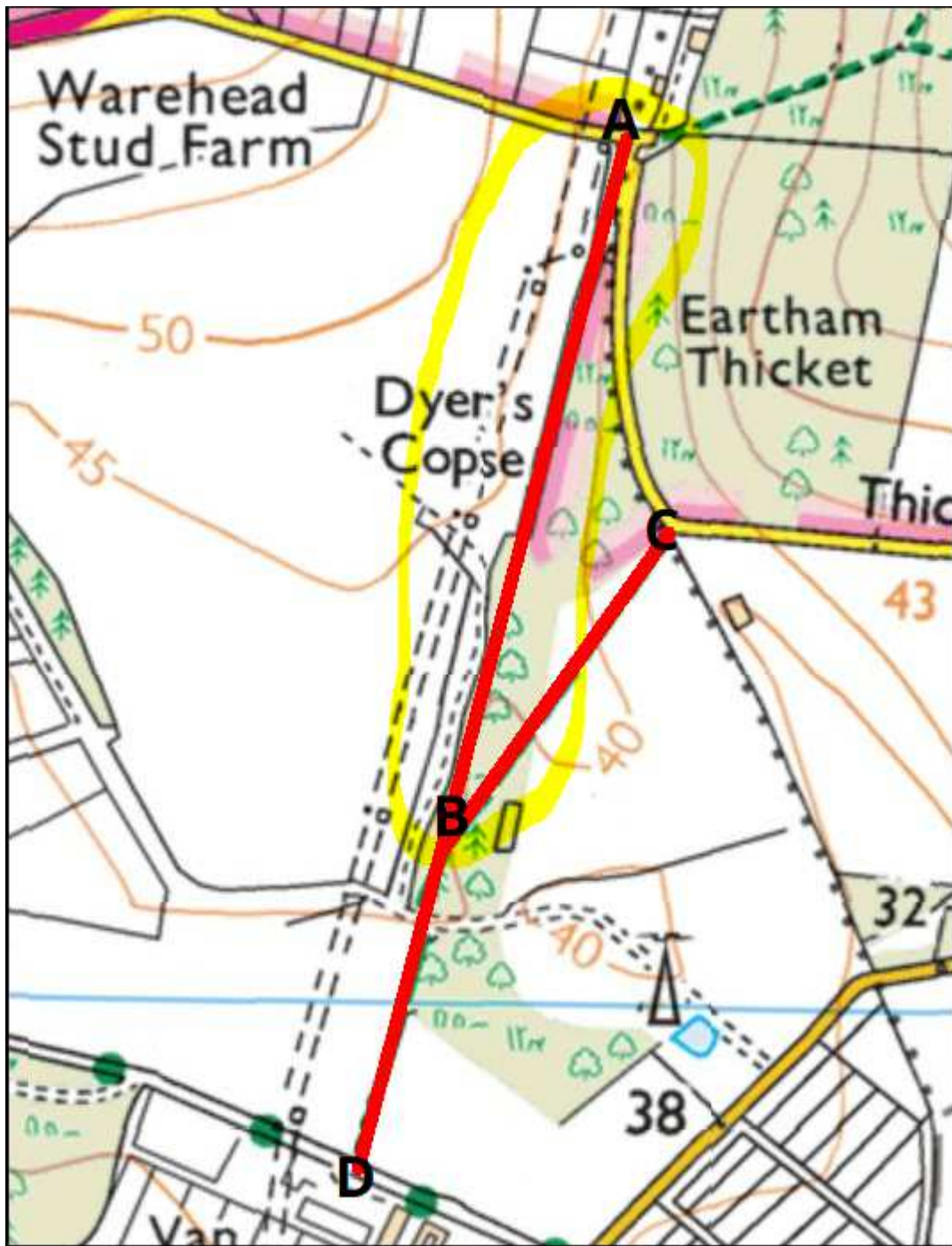
