- This table shows that West Sussex has a higher employment rate than Great Britain and the South East.
- The highest rate for districts in West Sussex is for Mid Sussex at 82.7% and the lowest rate is in Arun at 72.9%.
- For males the highest rate of 86.7% is in Horsham and the lowest is 77.8% in Arun. For females the highest rate is 81.1% in Mid Sussex and the lowest is in Arun at 66.3%.
