### Highways and Infrastructure

#### £17m funding agreed for A2300, Burgess Hill

I am delighted to announce that the Department for Transport has awarded West Sussex County Council [£17m funding](#) towards the A2300 improvement scheme at Burgess Hill. The [£22m scheme](#) aims to convert a 2.5km section of the existing road to a dual carriageway. It will reduce congestion, improve reliability for drivers and support growth in the region. The project will also see the addition of new walking and cycling paths. Work is expected to start this spring, with the road expected to be open in winter 2021.

#### Horsham Training Centre and Fire Station

Exciting proposals for West Sussex's first state-of-the-art fire service learning and development centre and new 24-hour fire station have been revealed. The County Council is proposing the £21m development for land off the A24 at Highwood Mill, near Horsham. A public exhibition to showcase the proposals will take place from 4 to 11 March at Horsham Library.
