8 RDPE Leader Funding

The RDPE* LEADER** programme, which runs until December 2013, is aimed at maintaining a viable farming and forestry industry, supporting rural businesses and helping local rural communities to remain viable.

There are two RDPE LEADER programmes in West Sussex, together bringing £3.93 million into the County for rural development. West Sussex County Council is acting as the Accountable Body for these.

One of the programmes covers the Three Harbours and Coastal Plain (£1.68m) and there is a Local Action Group (LAG) for this. The LAG comprises representatives of the local land based businesses and the local community.

The Three Harbours and Coastal Plain (THCP) programme has £1.68m of new money to run the programme and distribute to projects coming forward to the LAG. A maximum grant would be £50,000.

Peter Simpson, Rural Operations within the County Council's Sustainable Development Unit, will provide the CLC with information on the programme, including the themes and activities that will be covered by the THCP programme. The CLC will be asked to consider how it can assist in identifying eligible projects and encouraging applications.

**LEADER: Liaison entre actions de developpement rural (integrated action for rural development).

9 Civil Parking Enforcement

Parking enforcement is being taken out of the criminal environment (enforced by Sussex Police Traffic Wardens) and into the civil environment (enforced by local authority Civil Enforcement officers). The only current parking enforcement is just within the Chichester Controlled Parking Zone but Civil Parking Enforcement [CPE] will be across the entire District. It is programmed to go live from January 2010.

An agency agreement will be developed which will specify the terms and conditions within which the scheme will be operated on West Sussex County Council's behalf by Chichester District Council [CDC] through CDC's existing parking related infrastructure.

The County Council's Parking Contracts Manager, Chris Barrett, will inform the Committee of the application of CPE across the South Chichester CLC area.

10 Local Authority School Governors – Appointments & Re-Appointments

Major C J Hallam at Thorney Island Primary School when his current term expires on 31st August 2009.

Mr S Quigley at Chichester High School for Girls when his current term expires on 31st August 2009

Each of the above nominations has been supported by the school's governing body.

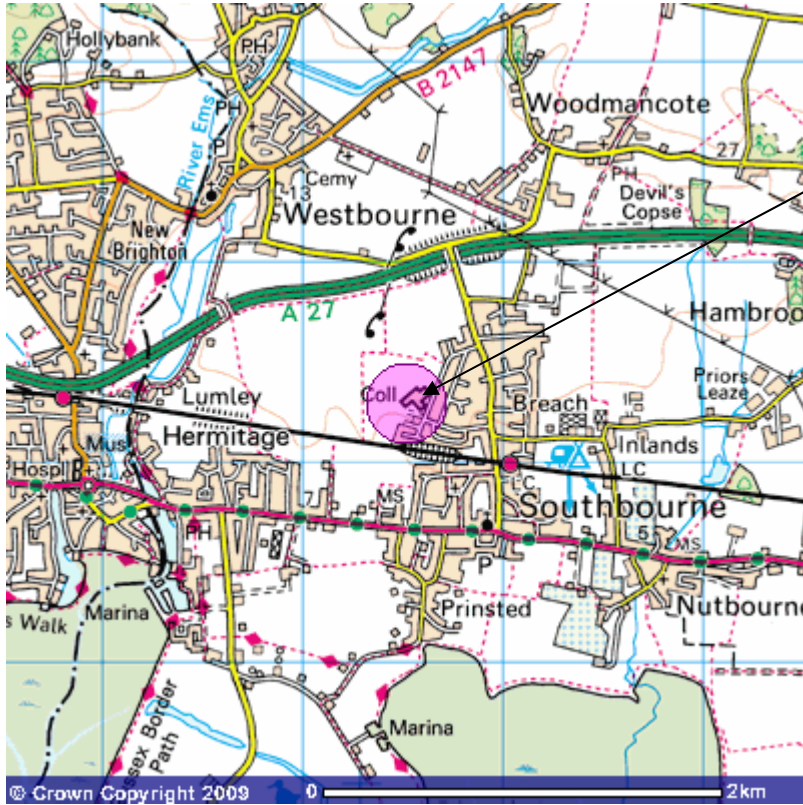
