3. **Minutes**

The Board is asked to confirm the minutes of the meeting of the Health and Wellbeing Board held on 17 July 2014.

4. **Health and Wellbeing of Children and Young People in West Sussex**

The Board will receive an overview of the demographic and health profile of children and young people in West Sussex and hear how services for children are jointly commissioned in the county. The services underpin the Board's agreed strategic areas of focus for Children and Families of supporting children and families with long term care needs and specifically support key strategic outcomes of;

- Improved mental and physical health of children and young people
- Ensuring families receive the support they need in a timely way
- Ensuring that children are safe and secure, and that
- Young people are ready for school and ready to work

The Board is asked to:

- a) Assess how well the health and social care system is working together and to identify any areas for improvement
- b) Consider whether resources and funding are used appropriately and effectively
- c) Identify any gaps or shortfalls in the services provided (particularly in terms of whether they reflect need) and make recommendations to key commissioners and service providers
- d) Identify any key issues for inclusion in the new Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy, currently under development

4a **Living healthy lives**

The Public Health team will present what is known about West Sussex children and young people in terms of; sexual health, smoking prevalence, obesity levels, alcohol and substance misuse. The team will outline current initiatives to address these issues, what successes have been evidenced and how these support the strategic priorities.

4b **Emotional health and wellbeing**

- i. Commissioners of Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS) will give a profile of the emotional wellbeing and mental health of young people in the county. This will include an exploration of the impact emotional wellbeing and mental health issues can have and the aims and objectives of current work towards CAMHS redesign.
- ii. Healthwatch West Sussex will present its briefing on issues in youth mental health ([attached](#))

4c **The healthy child programme**

The County Council Head of Children's Commissioning will outline a profile of the early years' population and current work towards the healthy child programme in West Sussex for people 0-19 years. The Board will also receive information on the potential for reshaping of health visiting and school nursing services to ensure a high quality, comprehensive and targeted service.

4d **Encouraging independence, personalisation and integrated working for disabled children and their families**

The Board will hear from care commissioners specialising in special educational needs and disability services (SEND) and a parent caring for a child with special educational needs. Commissioners will explain what is known about the population of children with SEND and the local context of numbers and needs. An understanding will be sought of family journeys and support needs and what changes are required to support better integrated services in the county to support those needs.

4e **Supporting families**

Commissioners will report on the context and data related to families needing support in West Sussex, giving case studies and updates on how the work of Early Help services and the Think Family initiative underpin the agreed strategic outcomes for children and young people.

4f **Supporting children and young people's health**

Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) and County Council commissioners will outline current data relating to the health needs of children and vulnerable young people including those with complex needs and those 'looked after' by the county. The Board will hear of plans for enhancing care in the community and ensuring robust care pathways to support the required health and wellbeing services.
