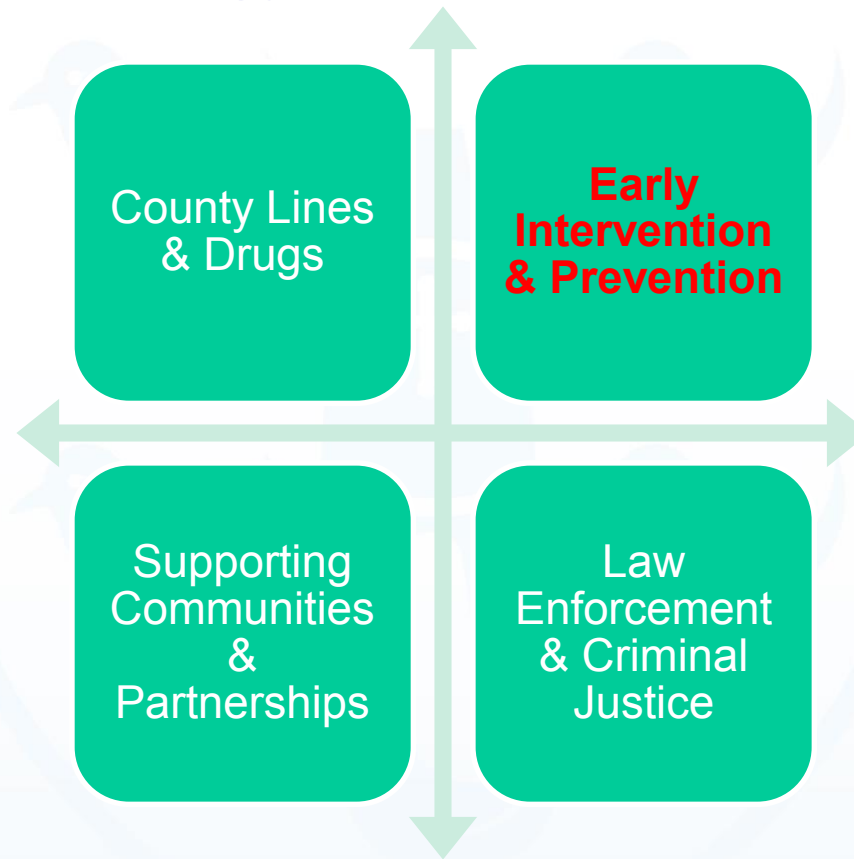
National Context

- Includes a new Offensive Weapons Act

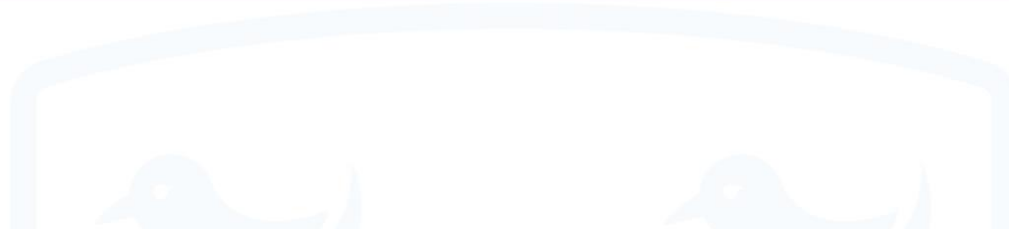

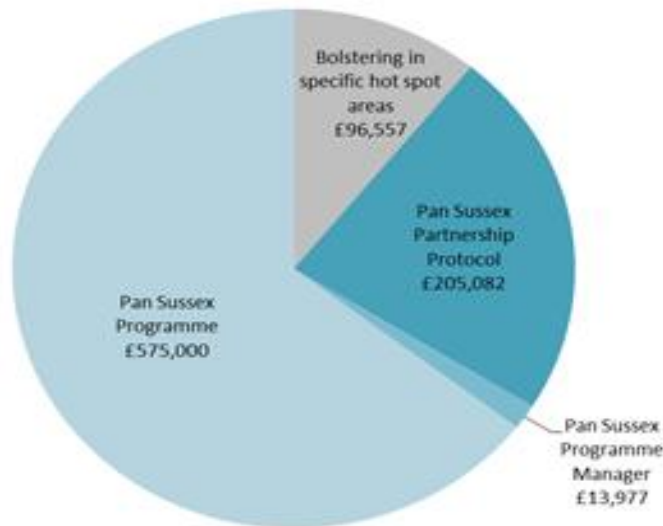

Where is the funding being spent?

2018/19 = £133,950

2019/20 = £756,666



The programme areas are as follows:

1. Sussex Early Intervention programme – PAN Sussex (£575,000)
2. Sussex Early Intervention Protocol – PAN Sussex (£205,082)
3. Positive activities funding for identified high risk areas – Five defined areas. (£96,557)
