#### Recommendation

i) That the Committee considers the Community Initiative Funding applications as set out in Appendix A and allocates funding according to the 2011/12 Funding criteria

## 1. Background

The Community Initiative Fund is a County Local Committee (CLC) administered fund that provides assistance to local community projects.

These funds are not for supporting the on-going revenue requirements of organisations; rather they are for the benefit of the North Mid-Sussex community by 'pump priming' new initiatives or supporting one-off applications for specific projects. Ideally, there should also be evidence of matched funding, either generated by the organisation or obtained from other sources.

The Parish Initiative Fund (PIF) is a CLC administered fund that provides match funding to Parish/Town Council led or supported projects aiming to enhance community capacity.

The County Council has agreed criteria by which applications will be awarded which can be accessed here: <u>2011-2012 Community Initiative Funding Policy</u>.

### 2. Current Applications

North Mid-Sussex CLC had £15,334 CIF to distribute during 2011-2012. Of this, £8,873 has been allocated, leaving £7,661 for allocation. One member sits on one further County Local Committee and has allocated their portion of the fund as follows:

Member for Lindfield & High Weald, £1,334 allocated.

There are currently three CIF applications, totalling £3,600 to be considered by the Committee. These are listed in Appendix A.

North Mid Sussex CLC has £1,200 PIF to distribute during 2011-12. Of this, £350 has been allocated, leaving a total of £850 for allocation.

There are currently no PIF applications.
