Library Service Consultation

A public consultation is currently underway focusing on the Library Service related budget saving proposals. The consultation closes on Wednesday, 13 November. It asks library users for their views on proposals to cease the mobile library service and to reduce the evening opening hours in the four main libraries (Chichester, Crawley, Horsham and Worthing) by one hour, from 7 pm to 6 pm.

The consultation will help inform the decision, due to be taken in November by the Cabinet Member for Fire & Rescue and Communities. The decision is one of a number of options being worked up to take forward in the 2020/21 budget to help meet the funding gap currently being faced by the County Council.
