Please promote Stoptober this October

Stoptober is back for its eighth year to help smokers split up from their relationship with smoking. Can you help us to reach out widely with this important message and share the availability of resources widely with your community networks?

The campaign runs from Thursday, 19 September through October and campaign information is now available on the [Wellbeing website](#). The annual Public Health England (PHE) Stop Smoking challenge encourages and supports smokers across England to quit for good, calling for smokers to sign up to quit smoking for 28 days on the national Stoptober website. This provides access to support such as digital resources and local stop smoking services.

To help you support the campaign, in addition to printed resources, this year a suite of digital and social resources is also available to download from the PHE Campaign Resource Centre. These include a partner toolkit and activation guide, graphics, social media posts, digital banners and screens.
