The Forward Plan contains details of all key decisions to be taken by the County Council, the Cabinet, Cabinet Members, County Local Committees and officers in the following four months. Key decisions are those which involve expenditure or savings of £500,000 or more or which will have a significant effect on communities in two or more electoral divisions. The latest version of the Plan covering the period September to December 2016 is now available and has been sent to all members. Since initial publication this edition has been re-published in order to amend the date of one decision in the Children – Start of Life portfolio as follows:

Design and Delivery of a safe and connected Prevention and Early Help System that makes sense to Children, Young People and their Families (September 2016).

This is because a review of the processes required before the service are able to commence wider engagement on proposals has indicated that the original timetable, with a Cabinet Member decision to proceed to this stage in September, is deliverable.
