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The County Council is required to provide a minimum of 28 days' notice for all key decisions. Key decisions are those which involve expenditure or savings of £500,000 or more or which will have a significant effect on communities in two or more electoral divisions. The Forward Plan, which is updated on a rolling basis, contains details of all key decisions to be taken by the County Council, the Cabinet, Cabinet Members, County Local Committees and officers in the following four months. The current Forward Plan was published on 6 April 2018.

Since the last edition of the Members' Information Service changes to the Plan have been made to:

- add a new decision to the Strong, Safe and Sustainable Place priority – Variation of the Recycling and Waste Handling Contract (RWHC) (May);
- add a new decision to the Prosperous Place priority - Adoption of the West Sussex Joint Minerals Local Plan (May); and
- amend the Allocation of Schools Access Initiative Funding 2018-23 (April) decision. The decision will now be taken by the Cabinet Member for Finance and Resources as the funding for the initiative will come from the Finance and Resources portfolio within the Capital Programme. Accordingly, the decision has been moved to the Council That Works for the Community priority.
