The Forward Plan, which is updated on a rolling basis, contains details of all key decisions to be taken by the County Council, the Cabinet, Cabinet Members, County Local Committees and officers in the following four months. The current Forward Plan was published on 11 September 2018.

Since the last edition of the Members' Information Service changes to the Plan have been made to:

- provide greater clarity about the nature of the proposals regarding Housing Related Support and the Local Assistance Network (LAN) Funding and the arrangements for stakeholder engagement that the decisions will set out;
- move the Approval of Guidance on Parking in New Developments decision in the Prosperous Place priority from September to November in order that the decision can be previewed by the Environment, Communities and Fire Select Committee on 14 November;
- move the Approval of the Strategic Transport Investment Programme (2018/19) decision in the Prosperous Place priority from September to October to correct an administrative error; and
- move the Approval of Halewick Lane Energy Storage Project decision in the Strong, Safe and Sustainable Place priority from December 2018 to March 2019, as the formal planning process is unlikely to complete in eight weeks as previously anticipated.
