The County Council is required to provide a minimum of 28 days' notice for all key decisions. Key decisions are those which involve expenditure or savings of £500,000 or more or which will have a significant effect on communities in two or more electoral divisions. The Forward Plan, which is updated on a rolling basis, contains details of all key decisions to be taken by the County Council, the Cabinet, Cabinet Members, County Local Committees and officers in the following four months. The current Forward Plan was published on 16 May 2019. Since the last edition of the Members' Information Service changes to the Plan have been made to:

- remove a decision from the Best Start in Life priority - Redesign of the Integrated Prevention and Earliest Help Service. As part of the comprehensive programme to raise and sustain standards within Children and Family Services following the outcome of the Ofsted inspection a wider service review is being undertaken. The way the services are delivered by IPEH and any need for change to this offer will be considered as part of this wider review. Should this result in any proposal that meets the criteria for a key decision, the appropriate governance process will be followed.
- add two new decisions to the A Prosperous Place priority:
 - Crawley Growth Programme: Funding and Governance (June); and
 - Framework for co-ordinating and approving events on West Sussex highways (June); and
- add a new decision to the A Council that works for the Community priority – Property development arrangements – procurement of a property development enterprise to work in partnership with the County Council (June).
