The County Council is required to provide a minimum of 28 days' notice for all key decisions. Key decisions are those which involve expenditure or savings of £500,000 or more or which will have a significant effect on communities in two or more electoral divisions. The Forward Plan, which is updated on a rolling basis, contains details of all key decisions to be taken by the County Council, the Cabinet, Cabinet Members, County Local Committees and officers in the following four months. The current Forward Plan was published on 24 April 2018.

Since the last edition of the Members' Information Service changes to the Plan have been made to:

- amend two decisions in the Best Start in Life priority – School Expansion Projects and Award of Contracts for School Expansion Projects – in order to add an expansion project at St Mary's Primary School, Bognor Regis (June);
- move a decision in the Strong, Safe and Sustainable Place priority – Adoption of Voluntary and Community Sector Partnership Principles – to May in order to allow further work on the proposals to be undertaken;
- add a new decision to the Council that Works for the Community priority - Allocation of Healthy Schools Capital Grant (May); and
- add a new decision to the Council that Works for the Community priority - Building Maintenance Services Contract (June).
