The Forward Plan contains details of all key decisions to be taken by the County Council, the Cabinet, Cabinet Members, County Local Committees and officers in the following four months. Key decisions are those which involve expenditure or savings of £500,000 or more or which will have a significant effect on communities in two or more electoral divisions. An amended version of the Forward Plan of Key Decisions, for June to September 2017, has been published in order to accommodate the following new entries:

- Service provision of the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service for children and young people who pose a risk of sexual harm to others (the Assessment Treatment Service) – request to continue arrangements until 30 March 2018 in the Children and Young People portfolio
- Procurement of a Dynamic Purchasing System (DPS) for Children's Placements and Other Support Services (SEND and Children's Social Care) in the Children and Young People portfolio
- Procurement of a Secondary Schools Catering Service Provider Framework in the Education and Skills portfolio
- Adoption of the West Sussex County Council Lead Local Flood Authority Surface Water Management Policy in the Environment portfolio.
