Further to our email exchanges at the end of June and the extension of time for service of my clients' statement of case I can now confirm that heads of terms for settlement of the objections have been agreed and we anticipate that the formal objections to the CPO will be withdrawn in due course.

While we settle the precise legal documentation to give effect to the settlement for withdrawal I should be grateful if the objections to the order as lodged could stand as the objectors' statements of case until such time as we are in a position to confirm formal withdrawal of the objection and withdraw from the inquiry processes. I am very alive to the approaching deadline for service of evidence and we will be working with WSCC to conclude matters urgently and will keep you fully informed of the likely date of conclusion of our legal agreement.

The above is without prejudice to my clients' rights to appear at the inquiry should matters agreed in principle not conclude as we expect which I very much hope will not be the case. You will understand that I must ensure their position is protected and cannot formally withdraw the objections until such time as a legally binding settlement is in place. I expect that to be in place very soon.
