Defence 1st Witness

The Accused states on oath: -

On May 2nd I was in BROWN LINE Trenches east of ARRAS and during the day I had the order to be ready to proceed to the FRONT LINE trenches, preparatory to "Going over the top". As the bombardment was very severe I became nervous and left the trenches moving towards ARRAS where I slept the night. The next day I went on until I came to ABBEVILLE and here I asked my way to ARRAS of the Military Police. They directed me but I lost my way and was eventually arrested in BERNAY.
