THE "HERITAGE" CRAFT SCHOOL.  
—A new development at the Heritage Craft School, Chailey, is the establishment of the Princess Louise Military Wards for wounded soldiers, who are treated under a scheme of educative convalescence, their minds being diverted by the practice of simple handicrafts in association with the crippled boys of the institution. Even those in bed are able in some degree to interest themselves in this way. The experiment calls for highly skilled nursing, in which several ladies connected with the charity have lent valuable assistance, and the crippled boys are heartily helping the Matron and staff. Surgical appliances, garments and other necessaries are much wanted, and a special appeal for contributions has been issued by Princess Louise, Duchess of Argyll.
