Official notice published in local newspapers - How much coal may I have?

PUBLIC NOTICES

HOW MUCH COAL MAY I HAVE ?

Between May 1 and October 31, 1945

COAL { House and Kitchen Coal
and Coalite 20 CWT.

CAN I HAVE IT ALL AT ONCE ?

If you live in the London, Eastern, South-Eastern, Southern or South-Western Regions, you may have delivery within the maximum, of as much as supplies will permit at any time up to October 31st.

If you live in any other Region, you can have up to 10 cwt. between May 1st and July 31st, and 10 cwt. between August 1st and October 31st.

Summer deliveries will count against the quantity allowed for the whole year, but supplies will not be sufficient for everyone to have the maximum of 20 cwt. in the summer.

COKE, ANTHRACITE, Welsh DRY STEAM COAL
and all manufactured fuels except Coalite 20 CWT.
In all districts, if supplies are available, at any time up to October 31st.

IF IN ANY KIND OF DIFFICULTY
consult your Local Fuel Overseer at your local Council Office he is there to help you. You can apply to him for a licence for extra fuel if you rely entirely on coal, or in cases of special need or unusual emergency.

REMEMBER THAT DURING THE FULL YEAR MAY 1st, 1945, to APRIL 30th, 1946,
you cannot obtain more than 34 cwt. of coal in the South or 50 cwt. in the North, except under licence. The maximum quantity in the coke group is 2 tons in all Regions.

**DO NOT BURN ANY FUEL UNLESS YOU MUST :
SAVE IT FOR THE WINTER.**
