## THE EXPULSION OF ALIENS. How Worthing Is Affected.

Under an Order in Council the County of West Sussex is added to the list of prohibited areas as specified in the Aliens' Restriction Order, and the effect has been to remove any alien enemy from the county, whether male or female.

It is understood that in this town about thirty families are affected by this latest Order, and the Police are taking the necessary steps to see that the terms of the regulation are complied with.

Those who are under orders to remove are not being inconvenienced in any way, due consideration being given to their circumstances. The Police provide travelling permits, and no distinction is made in any case. Superintendent Pennicott, who is charged to see that the town is cleared, has had many appeals made to him to allow those concerned to remain, as they have nowhere to go, but he has no option in the matter.
