Women Police.—The two first 'ladies in blue' for West Sussex were duly sworn in at Chichester on Friday before the Mayor, Sir Archibald Garland, namely, Miss Florence Ellis, daughter of the Deputy Chief Constable (Superintendent H. Ellis), and Miss Emily Thorn, sisterin-law to Inspector Brett. They will be engaged as special constables for clerical work, the County Council having decided to engage not more than eight with pay not exceeding 38s. per week with uniforms.
