West Sussex Joint Minerals Local Plan: Proposed Modifications

Following the Examination in Public of the West Sussex Joint Minerals Local Plan held in September 2017, West Sussex County Council and the South Downs National Park Authority has published its Schedule of Modifications for formal representations. Responses received will be sent to the Inspector for consideration before his final report is produced, determining whether or not the plan is 'sound' and legally compliant.

Document Title: West Sussex Joint Minerals Local Plan

Subject matter and area covered: The Joint Minerals Local Plan, as modified, sets out the background, the spatial context, strategies and policies to enable the delivery of sustainable mineral development for the period up to 2033. The plan includes a site allocation and is supported by a Key Diagram and Policies Maps.

Once adopted, the Joint Minerals Local Plan will replace the saved policies in the adopted West Sussex Minerals Local Plan 2003.

The area covered is the administrative areas of West Sussex County Council, as well as the portion of the South Downs National Park that lies within West Sussex.
