P:1110:10 <i>Apologies</i>	Apologies were received from Cllrs J Shaw (long-term absence) and C Warren (personal commitments).
P:1110:11 <i>Questions from the public</i>	There were no questions from the public.
P:1110:12 <i>Declarations of interest</i>	Cllr R Harber declared a personal and prejudicial interest in agenda item P:1110:16.
P:1110:13 <i>Minutes of previous meeting</i>	The minutes of the meeting dated 2 nd November 2010 were approved by all present and signed by the Chairman. <i>Proposed by P Kentell; Seconded by R French.</i>
