S:0310:01 <i>Apologies</i>	Apologies were received from Cllrs F Jones (work commitments) and J Shaw (illness).
S:0310:02 <i>Questions from the public</i>	There were no questions from the public.
S:0310:03 <i>Declarations of interest</i>	There were no declarations of personal or prejudicial interest by Councillors on any of the agenda items below
S:0310:04 <i>Minutes of previous meeting</i>	The minutes of the meeting dated 19 th January 2010 was approved by all present and were signed by the Chairman. <i>Proposed by S Birnstingl; Seconded by R French.</i>
S:0310:05 <i>Matters arising</i>	The Clerk reported as follows: S:0109:06 The cricket club have still not signed a contract. The Clerk was asked to write again, indicating that in the absence of a contract the Council will have to reconsider the status of the use by the cricket club. S:0909:10 Letters requesting proposals and a costed plan for playing field renovation were issued to 3 contractors (Active Grounds Maintenance, Sportsturf Maintenance, and Proground) on 9 th March. Proground have declined the work, and the other two are yet to reply.

S:0310:08 <i>Sports facilities project</i>	The Clerk reported that he had approached both County Cllr D Deedman and Mr Howard Collins of HDC regarding possible grants. Both indicated that detailed costings would be required. Cllr D Coldwell believed that a quantity surveyor's report was obtained several years ago. Both the Clerk and Cllr R Harber were asked to attempt to find this and ascertain its current validity.
