<b>Present:</b>	Cllrs R Harber (Chairman), D Coldwell, R French, F Jones, and J Shaw. Mr A Smith (UBFC) was present.
<b>S:0910:01</b> <i>Apologies</i>	Cllrs C Bailey, S Birnstingl and J Peake were absent.
<b>S:0910:02</b> <i>Questions from the public</i>	There were no questions from the public.
<b>S:0910:03</b> <i>Declarations of interest</i>	There were no declarations of personal or prejudicial interest by Councillors on any of the agenda items below
<b>S:0910:04</b> <i>Minutes of previous meeting</i>	The minutes of the meeting dated 17 <sup>th</sup> June 2010 were approved by all present and were signed by the Chairman. <i>Proposed by J Shaw; Seconded by F Jones.</i>
<b>S:0910:05</b> <i>Matters arising</i>	The Clerk reported as follows: S:1109:08 Trevor Beadle was emailed on 24-Aug-10 regarding a multi-use facility at the tennis court. He passed the issues to Howard Collins, who has replied with a set of queries. The Clerk was asked to invite Mr Collins to attend the next meeting of the committee. S:0510:12 The Cricket Club contract has now been signed, and a container key supplied. S:0510:13 A schedule of sports hall usage was circulated to members. The Clerk was asked to provide a summary of the information. S:0510:14 Paul Sweeney was emailed on 19-May-10 authorising him to progress the matter of decorating the skatepark via the user group. He replied "This is great news I will crack on with the user group organising and let you know asap".
<b>S:0910:06</b> <i>Cricket Club report</i>	No report was presented.
<b>S:0910:07</b> <i>Football Club report</i>	Mr A Smith indicated that he had replaced Mr G Morris as the UBFC liaison with the committee. He reported that the 6-a-side tournament in July had been a "massive success". He noted that the pitch renovation (sanding and verti-draining) was a vast improvement, other than at the goalmouths. All teams have started the new season well. The club have offered WSCC £250 toward the cost of gates in the new fence.

<b>S:0910:08</b> <i>Play areas</i>	Cllr Harber reported on the outcome of a meeting between himself, the Clerk, and Philip Clay on 25-Aug-10. Mr Clay was instructed to prepare detailed specification documents for application to tender
